

Albion girls win at Pennfield

Albion High School's girl's track team won the fourth annual Pennfield invitational track meet at the Pennfield High track Saturday.

Albion took the closely contested meet with a total of 95 points, followed by Marshall with 86, Hastings 85, Coldwater 52, Pennfield 46, and Harper Creek 37.

The Wildcat girls took five first place finishes, including the 880 and mile relays, the long jump, and the 100 and 220 yard dashes.

Karen Harris of Albion leaped 17 feet in winning the long jump, the best long jump

by a prep girl in the area this season.

Sue Zblewski of Marshall was the only double winner, with victories in the 440 and 880 yard events. Zblewski's times were 1:03.2 in the 440 and 2:26.7 in the 880.

Judie Ranger of Harper Creek won the high jump with a five foot effort.

Cindy DuPree, of the host Pennfield school, won the two mile run in a new school record time of 13:33.4.

Albion scored in all of the meet's 13 events except the two mile and the 110 hurdles. The Wildcat depth provided the winning margin over Marshall and Hastings.
