Girl Tracksters Soundly Beaten

The Coldwater high school girls' track team absorbed a double defeat at Harper Creek this week. The Beavers got by the Lady Cards 57-48, while the Hillsdale girls had an easier time, winning by a score of 70-35.

Although riddled with injuries, the local girls put up a good fight. Jan Linteau gave it her best as she won the high jump at 4'10". Judy Kasperski's time was several seconds off her best, but still good enough to win the half-mile. Her time was 2:42.2.

The only other meet winner from Coldwater was Sophomore Denice Dorr, who won the 440 on the slow track in a time of 1:06.8.

Harper Creek's upset of Coldwater was engineered by winning two of the three relays, Jenny beating Mary Jo Henderson in the shot put, and Bloomhuff outjumping Kasperski in the long jump.

Hillsdale captured more places and won all three relays against the local girls to secure its victory. The Hornets' 1:46.2

time in the 880 Relay would have been tough to beat even on a good day for Coldwater.

Besides this relay, the Hillsdale girls also captured seven other first places, plus a the seconds and thirds in the field events.

In an attempt to match these performances, Sue Gray placed against both teams in the mile. Tracy Snow did likewise in the 100, Pam Moore placed twice in the two-mile and Mary Blaski followed suit in the 220.

The girls will now try to recover in time for the Regionals in Pennfield tomorrow.
