Escanaba Girls Win In A-B; Ironwood 4th

MARQUETTE — Escanaba easily captured the girls' portion of the Class A-B, Upper Peninsula Track and Field Finals Saturday afternoon as the Eskimos scored 82½ team points to runnerup Marquette's 51.

Gwinn finished third with 29 points, followed by Ironwood with 16; Calumet, 14½; Menominee and West Iron with 14 each; Kingsford, seven; and Gladstone and Sault Ste. Marie with none each.

Ten new records were set in the meet as Escanaba's 800 relay team set a new time of 1:49.25; Kim Groleau of Marquette set a new pace in the 880-yard run with a time of 2:31.1; Denise Pintello of Gwinn set a new mark in the mile run, 5:35.3; Pat Rector a new mark of 11.65 seconds in the 100-yard dash; Vicki Davidson, Escanaba, set a new two-mile mark at 12:13.75; Gwinn's Pat Rector's time of 26.45 was a record in the 220; Marquette's mile and 440 relay teams set new marks of 4:18.45 and 52.6 seconds, respectively; Ann Van Dyke set a new shot put mark as the Eskimo tossed the shot, 35 feet 2½ inches; and Marquette's Shelly Chapman set a new high jump mark at 4-9.

Terry Tolvon was the highest place finisher for Ironwood, finishing third in the two-mile run. Susan Ringwall and Julia Perry finished third in the 100-yard dash and shot put, respectively while the 800 relay team and Martha Fitzgerald, in the mile run, finished fifth in their events.
