

# Grand Blanc wins relays

Grand Blanc's runners claimed four firsts and established two meet records in winning the 13th annual Davison Track Relays Monday night.

Bob Stallcup's Bobcats totaled 60 points to easily outdistance second-place Davison which had 48. Alpena was third with 42 and Clawson fourth with 40 markers. Fourteen schools competed.

Grand Blanc's 880-yard relay team of Charles Crouther, Neil LaBelle, Jim Manutes and Mike Evans set a record of 1:29.7 in that event and later followed

with a record 2:27.6 in the sprint medley relay. Members of that unit were Brian Groves, Crouther, LaBelle and Steve Barnes.

The Bobcats also won the middle distance relay and 440-yard relay.
