Dayton, Ohio, June 7: Good performances were the rule as the Ohio Association meet was staged at Welcome Stadium. Highlights were great battles in both the 2Mile and Mile relays, with Blue Ribbon coming out on top over Peoria in the longer race, and Peoria reversing the result in the 4-lap event. Deby LaPlante was on hand to win the 100mH, and Madeline M. Jackson scored a double victory in the 440/880. As usual, the Vetter sisters were on hand with their predictably good performances. Chicago State's Veronica Harris took the 100 in a windy 10.5. Kettering easily won the "in state" team title, while Peoria took the "out of state" crown over Blue Ribbon. The Results:
