

Fansher, Cooper Don't Place

Michigan Winner In All-Star Track Meet

FORT WAYNE — The doormat a year ago, Michigan did a little stepping on of its own here Saturday to win the second annual Tri-State high school all-star track meet.

The meet featured the outstanding seniors from Michigan, Indiana and Ohio, but it was the Michigan bunch who clearly stood out, piling up 173 points with Ohio second way back at 120 and the host Hoosiers third and last with 113.

Two area athletes, Richmond pole vaulter Jeff Fansher and Connersville high jumper Mike Cooper, competed but did not place in their events.

Michigan, last-place finisher in this meet a year ago, won 10 of the 16 events Saturday with sprinter Dwayne Strozier leading the way.

Strozier, from Flint Powers High School, won the 100 in 9.5, the 220 in 21.1 and anchored the 440 relay team.

Indiana could come up with only two first places, Gary West's Robert Buckingham winning the 440 in 48.3 and South Bend LaSalle's Greg Robertson taking the high hurdles in 14.1.

Richmond's Fansher cleared 13-6 but went out at 14-0 while Cooper of Connersville cleared 6-6 but dropped out at 6-8.

Strozier was named the star of stars in track while Ohio's Steve James won the same award for the field events. James hurled the discus 191-9.

Since this was only the second year for the meet, many of last year's automatic records fell with seven being bettered. Buckingham had In-

diana's only new mark with his 48.3 in the 440.
