

Linden captures Hamady Relays title

Sprinter Randy Rife sparked Linden to a 22-point margin and the championship in the Hamady Relays track meet Saturday.

Rife helped the Eagles to three of their outright victories with each triumph coming in a meet record time.

Linden won five events and tied Montrose in another to score 98 points. Montrose was second with 76, followed by Hamady 73, Lakeville 45, Bentley 38, Birch Run 27, Atherton 18, Durand eight and Bendle one.

There were nine records established including in the mile relay when Linden and Montrose were each timed in 3:33.6.

Linden's meet records came in the Hamady Relay, middle 400-yard shuttle and 880 relay.

Montrose won three events in addition to tying in the mile relay and figured in two other records, in the shot put and middle distance. Bentley set marks with its victories in the pole vault and Lakeville set a record in the shuttle hurdle relay.
