AMES, IA. — Iowa State's football team held a 2 1/2 hour controlled scrimmage Saturday, with running backs Mike Williams and Dexter Green combining for 312 yards rushing.

Williams, a senior, picked up 171 yards in 15 attempts and Green, a sophomore, got 141 yards in 21 carries. Said Coach Earle Bruce, "We have good, skilled people in our No. 1 backfield, but we need to find replacements to back up Mike and Dexter."

Bruce also said he was pleased with quarterback Wayne Stanley and Buddy Hardeman. Hardeman com-

pleted eight of 13 passes and rushed for 77 yards on four attempts while Stanley directed the scrimmage and Budd extremely well." Bruce

Bruce said that the team has been moved to the line spot, replacing Mike Williams and Dexter Green. Williams sidelined a week with a knee injury. Ron McFarland also was injured. Williams and Green were praised by Bruce for their performances in the defense. Said Bruce, "We have good, skilled people in our No. 1 backfield, but we need to find replacements to back up Mike and Dexter."
