Discus Mark Falls Again

Mac Wilkins increased his discus world record to 232 feet, 6 inches Saturday, breaking his week-old mark on each of his first three attempts at the San Jose Bicentennial Invitational track and field meet.

Wilkins reached 229-0 on his first throw, 230-5 on his second and then 232-6. His old record of 226-11 was set April 24. John Powell, a Pacific Coast Club teammate of Wilkins, held the record at 226-8 before Wilkins broke it. Powell, recovering from a pulled groin muscle, competed at San Jose, but was no challenge to Wilkins.

Buckeyes Impressive

Fullback Pete Johnson rumbled for four touchdowns while sophomore tailback Jeff Logan, the apparent successor to Archie Griffin, rushed for 174 yards to spark the Reds to a 47-0 victory over the Whites in Ohio State's annual spring football game Saturday. Johnson was Mr. Inside while Logan handled outside plays. The Reds rolled up 401 yards on the ground. And the No. 1 defense held the second White offense to minus three yards rushing and just 26 passing. About 15,000 fans were in attendance.

Mike Hurley Medalist

Western Michigan's Mike Hurley fired rounds of 69 and 66 over the par 69 Kent State University course this weekend in the Canadian-American Classic. Hurley led the Broncos to a 701 total, a 36-hole team record for both course and the tournament, which ended Saturday. It was the third tourney title this spring for Western which hosts its own invitational Monday at Lake Doster.

Saylor Ponders Offer

Hudson football coach Tom Saylor, who guided his team to a record 72 consecutive wins, setting the record with a playoff victory over Kalamazoo Hackett at Grand Rapids, is considering an offer to accept the coaching position at Massillon High School in Ohio. In 10 years at Hudson, Saylor has compiled an overall 85-4-1 record.

Wisconsin Gals Rule Big Ten

Wisconsin won the first Women's Big Ten Track and Field Championships Saturday, piling up seven first places and 175 points to outdistance runnerup Michigan State which had 141 points. Following in order were Minnesota, Illinois, Ohio State, Purdue, Iowa and Northwestern. Michigan and Indiana did not participate. Minnesota's Jane Oas set a national collegiate record in the 220 dash with a 24.1 clocking. She also won the 440. The meet was held at Michigan State.

Len Dawson Retires

Len Dawson, veteran quarterback of the Kansas City Chiefs, announced his retirement Saturday. In 19 years, Dawson threw 239 touchdown passes and accumulated 28,711 yards via the air lanes. He began his career with the Pittsburgh Steelers. Dawson said he has reached an agreement with NBC on a three-year contract to do telecasts.

Nellie Fox Honored

The Chicago White Sox Saturday retired the No. 2 jersey of the late Nellie Fox, who died of cancer last retired in White Sox history. The other was the No. 4 worn by Hall of Famer Luke Appling
