JACKSON — Sarah Peterson, Aini Maripuu and Karla Amble accounted for four first places among them and came up with some of the best times in the state to lead the Huron girls' track team to the title in Wednesday's South Central Conference Meet.

The River Rats finished with 110 points, well ahead of second place Adrian with 88 and third place Ypsilanti at 80. Pioneer, meanwhile, placed fourth followed by Jackson, and Jackson Parkside.

Despite the win, Huron finished only second in the final league standings because Adrian was first in the dual meet season and Huron tied for second. Pioneer was third in the final

standings.

Peterson won the 110-yard hurdles in :15.0, the same time she recorded in last Saturday's regional meet. She also won the long jump with a leap of 17-0, which is quite amazing because she rarely practices the event.

Pioneer's Brenda Hutton finished second in the hurdles in the school record time of :15.21. Cindy Damon finished fourth for Huron, and recorded her personal best time of :15.8 in the prelims.

Maripuu won the mile in the spectacular time of 5:23.5, winning by almost 100 yards and 20 seconds. Pioneer's Carol Thrane and Debby Mayotte finished third and fourth respectively and Huron's Anne Gilbert was fifth in her best time of 5:50.55.

Amble was possibly the happiest of all because she has been frustrated all year by her inability to break 12:00 in the two mile. She broke through that barrier with a vengeance with a time of 11:39.46. "Our strategy," said Huron Coach Ken Hillis, "was to have her run a little slower the first mile so she wouldn't be tired the second

mile." The plan worked to perfection, because she went out in 5:30 and finished in six minutes even.

There were no other double winners in the meet. Ypsilanti's Brenda Wilson won both the 100 and 220. Adrian's Helen Lewis won both the discus and the shot put. Huron's Debbie Mullice was second in the 100 and third in the 220.

Pioneer's Pat Schott won the 800 in the school record-time of 2:25.8 and teammate Lisa Illi was second in the discus. Other placers for Huron were Damon, who was second in the high jump, Joy Starks second in the 440 with a personal best of :59.72, Sue Williams fourth in the shot, Anne Klaffke

fourth in the 800 and Christine Nordman in the two mile.

Other Pioneer placers were Amy Conlin, second in the two mile, Joanna Bullard, third in the high jump, Nanette Fileccia, fifth in the 100, Karen Preston, fifth in the 440, Lori Fullerton, fifth in the discus, and Kathy Finneck, fifth in the 800.

Huron's mile relay team of Maripuu, Klaffke, Damon and Starks won the event in 4:13.65. Klaffke's performance as especially impressive because she filled in at the last minute and had never run the event before. Pioneer was second. Huron also finished second in the 800 relay and fourth in the 440 relay. Pioneer was

third in the 800 relay.

The final event of the season is the state championships on June 5th to be held at Bloomfield Hills Lahser.
