

# Ypsilanti Jumpers Go 6-9½ in State Track

Three high jumping records from Ypsilanti Central High—David Lewis and Victor Freeman—had a record-shattering effect Saturday in the 104 annual state track and field championships, as a first and a second day.

Indication of Detroit became the first team champion crowned during the first day. The Ravens won their first title ever at Ypsilanti capturing the Class C title with 23 points. Unconquered before was second with 16 and New Haven third with 13.

The Michigan men won the 800 and 400 for freshmen with a 16-second relay team of Lawrence Drake, John Mackintosh, Ben Johnson and Jeff Henson set a record of 48 seconds for a winning effort. Henson also won the 200-yard dash in 23.5.

The Northern High relay team won the 1900-yard dash in 13:30.

The Vikings edged neighborhood rival Flint Southeastern, 65-61, in Class A youth basketball final with 30 points.

Northern won their first with Mike Miller showing the way with a 21.4 effort in the 200-yard dash.

At Housenon Field in Grand Rapids, Lewis and Freeman set their best marks in the event at 6 feet 9½ inches, shattering the old mark by half an inch.

Although under a record, Bill Woodhouse of Grand Haven North and Tom James of Highland Park, won their respective 800-yard and 400-yard dashes in 1:58.4 heavily edging Ted Child of Westland John Green by two feet. James was four seconds off the record in winning the two mile in 9:07.7.

John Kucharski of Woodfield Hills, Lahar scored 15 first place girls with four 100-yard sprints while Jackson's Ronald French beat everyone in the race in winning the 100-yard dash in 23.1.
