

Boyd wins state title in girls cross country

POTTERVILLE — Port Huron High's Miriam Boyd finished first in the girls state Class A cross country meet Saturday with a time of 16:43. There were 141 entries in the event, which was held in Potterville.

Boyd's time in the three-mile event was her best of the season and set a new state record. The old record was 18:00.

Boyd's younger sister, freshman Ann, finished 46th place with a time of 20:10.

Yale finished sixth in the Class C meet, which was won by Decatur. Bulldogs' freshman Julie Stansberry made all-state by finishing tenth in 19:26.

Freshman Sue Hyde finished 41st in 21:24 for Yale and Laurie Hyde took 61st in 22:27. Josie Ligotti was 62nd, Kim Edwards 67th, Karen Krzak 73rd, and Caryl Poitra 85th.

Yale will holds its second annual boys and girls cross country invitational October 31 at 2:30 p.m. at the Melvin Hills Golf Club.
