

Bishop Borgess wins 'A-B' Spartan relays

Holt scored in all but one relay Saturday afternoon and Lori Schaffer turned in two fine individual performances, leading the Rams to a third place finish in the Spartan Relays for Class A and B High School girls. Redford Bishop Borgess successfully defended its crown, totalling 39 points. Walled Lake Western was second, with 32, and Holt had 25 in the meet held at MSU's Jenison Fieldhouse.

SCHAFFER TOOK fourth in both the mile and two mile. Saginaw Douglas MacArthur's Mary Ann Opalewski won both races, the latter in record time. She ran home in 11:09.71, eclipsing the mark set Friday by Lansing Catholic Central's Cindy Sprague in Class C-D competition.

The outstanding Holt two-mile relay team of Joy Parker, Julie Rogers, Shannon Grable and Lynn Wout was more than 13 seconds faster than the Bishop Borgess foursome.

Kyn Cole and Marilyn Barnes each ran on three of the Rams' relay teams. The two helped Holt to sixth in the sprint medley relay and fifth in the 880 relay.

PONTIAC CENTRAL bettered the shuttle hurdle relay mark it set two years ago, winning the event in :34.3.

Sexton's Josephine Mask finished fourth in the shot put, with Mason's Laurel Heskett right behind. Shelia Warren, of Waverly, was a finalist but didn't place in the top six.

Sexton's Jill Chenault took fourth in the long jump, while Waverly's LaDean Watts was a finalist but did not place.

THE WARRIOR'S sprint medley relay team of Debbie Laraway, Warren, Diane Caper and Watts finished fifth. Laraway added third place in the mile run, clocking 5:40.44.
Bishop Borgess iced the meet with a record setting performance in the meet finale, establishing a mile relay mark of 4:10.7. The previous record of 4:12.07 was set by Walled Lake Western in 1976.
