GP North Stars Top Spartan Meet

EAST LANSING · Bill Weidenbach of Grosse Pointe North and Dennis Lewis of Ypsilanti were the track and field stars here Saturday night in the 14th annual Spartan Relays.

Weidenbach, Michigan's premier miler, turned in two sensational races to lead coach Tom Gauerke and his Norsemen to their

first team title here since 1970. Grosse pointe North scored in 10 of the 15 events to win with a top heavy 53 1/3 points. Weidenbach anorched the Norsemen's winning distance

medley relay team (21/2 miles) to the fastest time recorded yet this season in national schoolboy ranks. The Norsemen were clocked in 10:17.1 with Weidenbach turning in a 4:13.7 anchor leg.

Weidenbach came back later in the evening to win the open mile in 4:16.36 and was named the meet's outstanding performer.

Lewis, the sensational Ypsilanti high jumper, set a meet record of 6 feet 91/2 inches and barely missed at seven feet. Gauerke got points from 16 of his 19 performers. Ken Humes set a school record of 6-foot-6 in finishing second to Lewis in the high jump. Dan Beck turned in a fine performance for North running the 34-mile leg on the distance medley in 3:08 and turning in quarter mile dashes of 51.8 and 52.5 on two other
