Fraser Audioland is making the big move to the Major Metro Travel League. The Fraser slowpitch softball team, which finished seventh last year in the United States Slowpitch Softball Association World Class B tournament, is replacing Little Caesars as the eighth team in the Metro circuit. Caesars was expelled from the league last week.

Audioland has a balance of experience and youth. Two former Major Metro players, Mitch Ritter and Mickey Axelson, and Mt. Clemens Clintondale High Athletic Director Jim Smith are the veterans.

Audioland gets its first taste of Major Metro play tomorrow night in its double-

header against Wolverine Bumper-No. 1 Mobile Homes, which won its season-opening doubleheader last Tuesday at the Softball City complex on the State Fairgrounds.

In other Major Metro doubleheaders tomorrow night at Softball City, defending league champion Snyder's takes on Lonnie's (formerly PUSH), Bert's Blackhorse meets E.J. Steve and Burke's Sports Haven plays Dubin Construction.

Dubin contraction surprised Snyder's last week with a split of their doubleheader. All douleheaders begin at 7:15 p.m.

Thursday's schedule matches Snyder's against Audioland, Lonnie's with Wolverine, Bert's against Burke's and Dubin with E.J. Steve. The league has 56 games

scheduled this season, eight more than last year.

Little Caesars was expelled from the league after managers said they felt there was a conflict in interest because Little Caesars also has a professional team. Little Caesars is keeping the players from its Major Metro team together and is scheduled to play in the Classic leagues at Softball City.
