# Diemer, Wyoming Lee Take State Run Titles; Christian Falls Short

HASLETT — For Brian Diemer, it was just like any other time he has run this fall.

For Wyoming Lee, it was just like earlier in the decade.

But for Grand Rapids Christian, it was much like last year.

20 Diemer and Lee both wound up with state championships and Grand Rapids Christian wound up with another near miss at the Class B-C cross-country meet on a sunny Saturday.

Diemer, South Christian High School's distance star, cruised tovictory in the race for invidividual runners in Class B to improve by one notch his finish of one year ago.

Lee notched the third state championship in its history and first since 1972 on what Coach Art Kraai termed "a great team effort."

But Christian, City League champion and rated No. 1 in the state, came up 12 points short of Holly, a team it had defeated earlier in the year in an invitational, in the race for the Class B team title.

All fall, Diemer, the Sailors' fine-tuned running instrument, has stayed at least 20 seconds ahead of his opposition.

The runners in the state finals also would have gotten a nice rear view / — if they were carrying binoculars.

While Diemer was crossing the finish line situated at the 50-yard line of Haslett High School's football field, his competition still was winding through the weeds well behind the field.

Diemer finished in 16:12.9 over a course that was 300 yards longer than the prescribed three miles; his nearest pursuer. Kurt Mast of Holland Christian, crossed the finish line in 16:41.3

"This is what I've wanted since last year," smiled Diemer, not even breathing hard after winding his way through the finish chute. "A state championship. I also wanted the fastest time, but I don't know if I got it yet."

He didn't. His winning time was two seconds slower than that of Mark Smith of Cadillac, individual winner of the team race.

Lee, which won back-to-back state titles in 1971-72 under Coach Art Kraai, added a third, despite placing only one runner among the top 15.

"I didn't think we'd win it," said Kraai. "Breckenridge was favored. They were No. I all season."

But Lee's 123-point total was 12 ahead of Breckenridge at 135.

Bill Bainbridge led the Rebel surge with a sixth place finish in 16:49.8. Then came the tightly-banded Rebels who provided the victory: Jody Lowing 21st, Wendell Ratliff 26th, Jim Melinn 30th and Scott Holford 40th.

In the invidiual race, White Cloud's Mike Maike ran to second place in 16:51.

"John Brink ran his greatest race of the season," praised Christian Coach John Warners. "He saved the best for last, and got stronger during the second half of the race."

Brink, two-time City League champion, surged from seventh place halfway through the race to a third-place finish in 16:34.4, but it wasn't enough to bring the Eagles the title.

West Michigan runners nearly owned the top ten places in the individual race in Class B. After the 1-2 finish of Diemer and Mast, Al Ross of Ludington finished third, John Adams of Spring Lake fourth, Phil Walcott of Jenison sixth and John Foss of Delton eighth.

#### Class A-D

With four finishers in the top 15, Brighton High School notched only 85 points to run away with the Class A cross country state championship Saturday at Howell and Akron-Fairgrove edged Mancelona by three points to take the Class D title.

Grand Haven placed 10th in the 25-team Class A division.

Doug Tolson of Wayne Memorial won the individual team race and Jim Miller of Adrian took the individual race, both finishing in 14:47.4. Brian Nevins of Rockford finished 13th in 15:26. East Kentwood's Mike Schmuker and Steve Orchard came in 19th and 38th and Bob Brock and Dave Niles of Holland West Ottawa finished 22nd and 29th.

In the Class D individual race, Trent and Wade Chipman of Saranac completed the race seven seconds apart in sixth and seventh. Allendale's Shannon Moore finished 11th.

Rod Vrevard of Detroit East Catholic had the best Class D time, winning the team race in 15:18.
