Redford and Mumford high schools won west side track titles Friday as the Public School League launched its spring playoff competition.

Redford's boys team rolled up 117 points to take the boys title at Central High. Central finished second with 84, Chadsey third with 75 and Mumford fourth with 66. Earl Wilkins of Redford won the high jump and long jump while Randy Woodsen, also of Redford, won the 440 in 49.1 seconds and place second in both the half mile and high jump.
