

ROD Boys, Girls Defeat Kimball

Favored Royal Oak Dondero High won both the boys and girls dual meets Wednesday in its long-awaited matchup against Royal Oak Kimball.

The Oak boys won a squeaker, 81½-76½, while the Dondero girls were 78-58 winners.

It was the first varsity competition held at the Dondero track this spring. Repairs are being made to improve the facilities.

The Dondero boys finished with a 10-0 dual meet record, the girls 9-0, while Kimball's squads suffered their first losses of the season, falling to 8-1 and 12-1 respectively.

Dondero's Skip Ballish was the only double-winner in the boys meet, capturing the shot put and discus. Kimball was victorious in all three relays.

Dondero freshman Cheryl Gulli was a double-winner in the girls competition, taking the 100 and 220. She also was a member of the winning 880-relay team. The Oaks took all three relays.

Morehouse (two-mile and mile) and Debbie Peters (hurdles and high jump) also were double-winners.

"I'd like to see a combined Dondero and Kimball team — that would be one great team," said Oak assistant coach Stu Asch. "The Kimball coaches and team did a great job this year."

All four squads are league champions and the Dondero and Kimball girls teams finished 1-2 at the Oakland County meet. The Oaks were third and the Knights 11th at the boys county meet.

On Saturday, members of the Royal Oak teams and other South Oakland qualifiers will compete in the state meets at several sites.
