GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. OFFICIALS The Officials' Tent will be located near the center of the football field.
- 2. <u>REGISTRATION</u> Coaches should pick up their packet near the Main Gate. Contestants' numbers, pins, programs and heat and lane assignments will be issued. Coaches must make sure their contestants wear assigned numbers.
- *3. TEAMS WITH RELAYS Relay cards are enclosed in the coaches packet. It is the coaches responsibility to record name, number, and school on the relay cards to be presented to the Clerk of Course.
- 4. <u>DRESSING ROOM</u> Two dressing rooms will be available for contestants. #1 and #2 locker rooms are located under the stadium. Schools should use their own towels. Valuables should be checked with your coach or some other reliable person.
- 5. MEALS Schools are responsible for their own meals. Meal tickets may be purchased for \$2.00 per person at the Concession Stand. Meals will be served in the cafeteria of Northwestern Community High School starting at 11:00 A.M.
- 6. CONTESTANT SEATING AREA All contestants must sit in the designated area as shown on enclosed map. This area will be in the N.W. section of the stands.
- 7. BULL PEN The bull pen will be located at the northwest end of the Stadium.
 All contestants should report to the Clerk of Course in this area.
- 8. TRAINING A physician and trainer will be available in the bull pen area.
- 9. WARM UP The warm up area will be on the west side of the Stadium in the Driver Training Area. Contestants should be warmed up and ready to compete on the scheduled time.
- 10. TIME SCHEDULE A time schedule has been included for your convenience.
- 11. TRACK EVENTS All track events of 440 yards or more will be run from the center of the straightaway in front of the stands. The 100 yard dash and 120 yard high hurdles will be run in front of the stands. The 220 yard dash will start on the opposite side of the track with staggered starts and finish in front of the stands. The 330 yard low hurdles will start on the opposite side of the track and finish in front of the stands.
- 12. <u>FIELD EVENTS</u> All Field Events will be held in the areas indicated on your enclosed map. The long jump may be held in one of two pits depending upon the wind direction.
- 13. HEAT QUALIFIERS The selection of qualifiers to the Semis and Finals of the Dashea and Hurdles will be by place finishes in preliminary heats and the time for the 5th place winners as indicated on the heat sheet.
- 14. <u>SCRATCHES</u> Final scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie by 9:30 a.m. at the concession stand. All contestants entered in an event must compete in that event, or the contestant will be disqualified for the remainder of the meet.

NOTE: All finals will be run in order and as fast as possible. There will be no delays for runners in the finals.

All contestants will remain in the stands until 1st call is made whereby they will be allowed to enter the bull pen.

All final scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie at the concession stand by 9:30 a.m.

Your cooperation is requested to keep contestants and spectators in their proper places as outlined below. Please discuss these items with your team:

- 1. All track shoes MUST HAVE ½" SPIKES OR LESS in order to run on the all-weather track. Trackmen who do not follow this rule WILL NOT be allowed to participate in the track meet.
- 2. Gill starting blocks will be available for use. No individual school starting blocks will be permitted on the track.
- 3. Contestants and coaches should stay in the northwest section of the stands as designated.
- 4. Please ask your athletes to stay away from officials at the finish line.
- 5. Each team is expected to furnish its own equipment in all field events.
- 6. Rules governing the State Meet are set forth in the 1978 Track and Field Rule Book and the Michigan State Athletic Department Bulletin of March, 1978.
- 7. Please warm up 15 minutes prior to the time indicated in the track and field events.
- 8. NO EVENT will be held up for contestants not at the starting post.
- 9. We would appreciate all coaches staying with their team and keeping them in the designated seat area.
- 10. The coach is to pick up all medals for his team at the conclusion of the meet at the official's tent.
- 11. There will be no SUBSTITUTIONS for athletes qualifying from the Regional Entry Form except as allowed in the relay events.



Subject: Order of Events and Meet Regulations

When boys and girls meets are conducted simultaneously, girls track events shall precede boys track events except as indicated in the following order of events. If meets are not run simultaneously, then the events for the contestants not participating are to be eliminated from the order of events.

NOTE #1: 330 Yard Low Hurdles at all Regional and Final Meets (where possible) are to be run so that the curve is in the middle of the race.

NOTE #2: Boys' races may not be counted as intervening events for girls, nor may girls' races be counted as intervening events for boys.

FIELD EVENTS

Discus Boys Pole Vault Boys Shot Put - 12 1bs. Girls Shot Put - 8 lbs. High Jump Long Jump

NOTE #3: Field Events need not be conducted in the above order.

NOTE #4: Dual meets are to be scored 5-3-2-1, therefore, a school may enter four contestants per individual event.

Preliminaries, WHEN NECESSARY, will run in the following order: Combined Boy-Girl Meets - 100 Yard Dash, 110 Yard Low Hurdles, 120 Yard High Hurdles, 220 Yard Dash.

Each Regional and Final Manager is to establish a preliminary session scratch meeting and a final session scratch meeting. All contestants entered in events for that session of competition in the Regional or the Final Meet, who do not plan to participate in all of their events for that session, must be scratched not later than the end of the scratch period for that session. All contestants who remain as entries in an event will be disqualified from further competition if they fail to compete in an event in which they are entered. Each Regional and Final Meet Manager will make the necessary adjustment in the heat assignment following the conclusion of the scratch period for each session.
