

Montrose sprints to girls' track title

EAST LANSING — Montrose High captured only one first place finish Friday afternoon, but it was enough to win the fifth annual Spartan Relays for Class C and D high school girls at Jenison Field House on the campus of Michigan State University

Montrose won the sprint medley relay, breaking the meet record it set a year ago. Liz Greene, Media Bragg and Palastean Harris were on the relay team that set the record last year. This time they were joined by Mary Nielsen and betterd their mark by 3.1 seconds.

Melanie Weaver of Mason County Central was the meet's only double winner, setting records in both the one- and two-mile runs as she helped her team to a second place finish. In all there were meet records set in eight of the 10 events.
