

Prep ace jumps to top spot

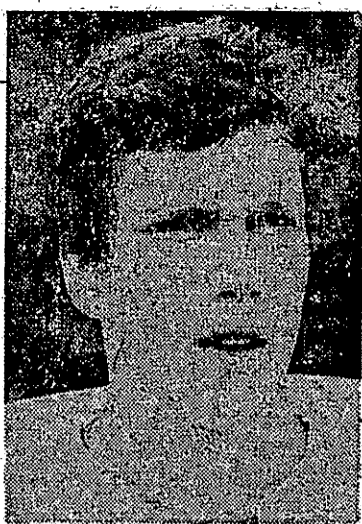
Derek Harper's winning long jump of 23 feet, 9 1/4 inches in last weekend's Mansfield Relays gives him top billing in The Detroit News' initial weekly track listing of outstanding efforts by state high school athletes.

Vincent Bean of Southfield trails in the long jump listing with a 23-5 1/2 jump that won the indoors event at the Spartan Relays a week ago at East Lansing. Ken Brown of Flint Northern has accounted for the third best effort with a 23-5 jump that also merited a third place at Mansfield. Harper of Pontiac Northern earlier also won the Huron Relays at Ypsilanti.

The present state Class A record is 23-11, set by John Ross of Detroit Mackenzie seven years ago and duplicated a year later by Kelsey Johnson of Detroit Osborn.

A fourth Michigan schoolboy also has cleared 22 feet. He is Angelo Bradshaw of Flint Northwestern at 22-4 1/2, also attained indoors.

A keen rivalry is anticipated for the high jump if early results can be used as a yardstick. John McIntosh of Sterling Heights Stevenson has had the best effort

so far at 7 feet.

Three others cleared 6-9 at Mansfield — Paul Piwinski of Warren Cousino, Jon English of Birmingham Brother Rice and Dave Elliott of Ann Arbor Pioneer.

Elliott, a senior, is the younger brother of basketball All-Stater Bob Elliott, now at Arizona under Coach Fred Snowden. Dave's 6-9 earned a second-place finish in the Mansfield competition behind Milton Ottey's record-tying effort of 6-11 1/4 for Toronto Eaton.

A year ago Piwinski set the state Class A record of 6 feet, 10 1/2 inches.

The News' initial listing covers only eight of the normal 16 events, due primarily to the brief schedule of outdoor action thus far. Coaches are urged to call in their best efforts to Bruce Waha, an assistant Michigan State track coach, at (area code 517) 546-9487, between 8 and 10 p.m.
