

Four are double track winners

Norman Graham in the 18-and-over division and Derrick Smith, Steve Taylor and Rod Turner in the 17-and-under division were double winners Thursday in an all-comers track meet at Houston Stadium.

Graham, from Southwestern High, won the 100-yard dash in 9.9 seconds and the 220 in 22.0.

Smith, from Northwestern High, cleared 6-4 in the high jump and won the 220 in 22.5. Taylor, from Ainsworth High, won the shot put at 47.5 3-4 and the discus at 142-1. Turner, from Northern High, won the 120 high hurdles in 14.6 seconds and the 100 in 9.8.

Turner, Taylor and Smith also were second in one event.

Despite several outstanding times, no records were broken.

This meet has been going for a long time and we've had some great collegiate runners so it's not unusual that there were no records, said Meet Director Don Marsh.
