All weather track -- eight (8) lanes, all weather runways, all weather pad takeoff in high jump, concrete disc and shot put rings, grass runway for javelin. Seating capacity -- 3,000. Restrooms available.

AGE DIVISIONS: Competition for both boys and girls will be held in the Intermediate (14-15) and Senior (16-17) Divisions. Contestant's age is determined as of January 1, 1979. A copy of birth certificate MUST accompany all entry applications.

QUALIFICATIONS: * Athletes qualify for the National Decathlon-Pentathlon by placing 1st or 2nd in the Regional.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Postmarked by July 20, 1979.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per athlete

COMPETITION TIME: Decathlon will start at 10:00 AM on August 4 & 5, 1979.
Pentathlon will start at 10:00 AM on August 4, 1979.

IMPLEMENTS: All throwing implements will be supplied by local sponsor -- contestants must bring their own vaulting poles.

INTERMEDIATE DIVISION, Ages 14 and 15

(1) The Decathlon shall consist of ten (10) events which shall be held in two (2) consecutive days in the following order:

(2) The Track and Field Rules of the Amateur Athletic Union of the United States shall apply with the following exceptions:

- (I) In the long jump, shot put, discus throw, and the javelin throw, each competitor shall be allowed three (3) trials only.
- (II) In the running events and hurdles, a competitor shall be disqualified in any event in which he has made three (3) false starts.
- (III) Shot Put -- The 12 lb. shot shall be used.
- (IV) High Hurdles -- Distance, 120 yards, ten (10) 39-inch hurdles shall be used, placed ten (10) yards apart; fifteen (15) yards from starting line to first hurdle; fifteen (15) yards from last hurdle to finish line.
- (V) Discus Throw -- The high school discus shall be used (3 lbs. 9 oz.)

(3) The winner shall be the competitor who has scored the highest number of points in all events, awarded on the basis of the International Amateur Athletic Federation Scoring Table. In case of a tie, the winner shall be the competitor scoring the greater number of points in a majority of the events. If the tie still continues, the winner shall be the competitor scoring the greatest number of points in any one (1) of the ten (10) events. This procedure shall apply to ties for any place in the competition.

(4) The heights and distances in the field events shall be measured in the metric system for scoring purposes.

(5) The International Amateur Athletic Federation *(IAAF) scoring table shall be used to score events. (See note below)

(6) In the running events, each competitor shall be timed by three (3) watches.

(7) A competitor failing to start or take a trial in any event of the competition shall be considered to have abandoned the competition and shall not be allowed to participate in any following event. He shall, therefore, not be included in the final placing or scoring.
