

Prep harriers to run nationals

SHAWNEE MISSION, Kan. -Seven Wisconsin prep cross country runners competing in regional competition Saturday, including individual champions, Tim Hacker of Menomonee Falls North and Cathy Branta of Slinger, qualified for the TFA/USA National Championship meet in Cali-

Wisconsin won the girls' team title with 31 points, and Wisconsin United could have clinched the boys' crown had they had a fifth finisher in races over the 5,000-meter course.

Hacker was clocked in 14 minutes, 39 seconds and Marathon Track Club's John Easker, Wisconsin Class B state champion from Wittenberg-Birnamwood, finished second in 14:51. Madison Memorial's Rob Aubey, running for Wisconsin United, wound up sixth at 15:18. Also qualifying was Kenosha Bradford's Scott Jenkins.

Branta and Racine Case's Stacy Bant finished 1-2 in the girls' 5,000 in 17:21.4 and 17:23, respectively. Branta broke a course record. Wisconsin United's Ellen Olson, standout Madison West runner, finished fourth in 17:45.
