Women Sweep State Meet

For the second year in a row the Greenhills Girls' C-C team, guided by "Coach of the Year" Bruce Dyer, won the state title. Led by senior Robin Magee, who won her third consecutive championship, the team became the first in Greenhills history to successfully defend a state title.

At the best meet of the year, the Potterville Invitational, each girl had an incredible showing. Robin Magee won overall, Lucy Chambers and Sandy Irani took the junior race, Kris Cowan and Sarah Marsden were runners-up in the sophomore race, and the strong freshman team of Sue Gunn and Jenny Cox finished fourth in their race. The team defeated Class B and C schools at the Springport, Manchester, and Brandywine Invitionals, then performed as expected in the Class D state meet, winning by 14 points. Despite the loss of key runner Teresa Casey due to an injury, the Gryphons had another excellent year. The goals for next year's team are to have a healthier season, to run seven girls in each race and to string up more state championships.
