

DEDICATION

For the past two seasons, Southfield's Track
Program has been fortunate to have Coach Jerry Kocsis.
During these seasons he completely rebuilt the Blue
Jays' hurdle program that climaxed this year in a
League Championship in the High Hurdles and places
at the Regional and Oakland County Meets in the Low
Hurdles. Aside from heading up the hurdle program,
Jerry collected and recorded nearly every time and
split in every event during the 1980 season. As
Equipment Director of the 1980 All Oakland County
Meet, Jerry played an integral part in assuring the
success of that meet.

So, it seems fitting that the Season Summary Booklet of the 1980 Track Season be dedicated to Jerry Kocsis.

PREFACE

For the Blue Jays, the 1980 Track Season was a successful one. They began the season inexperienced, young, and uncertain about the future; and in two months time established themselves competitive in one of the toughest track counties in the State. The strongest area of team improvement came with the development of depth. They found they could cover for injuries and technical errors and still hang tough.

In SMA competition, Berkley and Hazel Park tied for Last Place. Berkley lacked the all-around talent to win dual meets but out-scored Hazel Park at the League Championships. Berkley boasted League Champion Half Miler, Tom Hammett who also went on to earn the County Championship in the Half. Hazel Park could win dual meets, but an injury to top athlete Lou Coronado cost them in the season's stretch drive.

Kimball and Southfield tied for Third Place and it seems that this year the two teams have passed each other headed in opposite directions success-wise -- Southfield up, Kimball down. The Knights were fortunate to nip Southfield in an early dual meet, but the Jays out-scored them at the Championships led by Vincent Bean, Long Jump; and Darryl Harris, High Hurdles. 1980 was the third season in 16 years that Kimball didn't produce a single League Champion.

Ferndale had the perfect dual meet record, but Seaholm had the Individual Champions (Steve Ross, Discus, Jim Roth, Pole Vault; Steve Rose, Shot Put; Scott Harper, Mile & Two Mile; Mark Redman, 440; Andy Fremuth, Low Hurdles; and a Mile Relay team that only the Jays had a shot at beating). Ferndale had its glory at the League Meet in the Sprints led by 100 & 220 Champion LaBron Oldham. He also played a key role in 2 SMA Record setting Sprint Relays. Nate Law chipped in with a Championship in the High Jump but it just wasn't enough as Seniorladen Seaholm just wasn't to be touched. Result: the two teams ended the track season Co-Champions in the SMA.

In 1981, the Jays will have experience and will be looking for a group of ROOKIES as talented as this season's crop. We now look to next season and to what we can do as individuals to promote and improve Southfield Track & Field. We all understand what it means to make a commitment to self-improvement and to take pride in honest work.

1980 SOUTHFIELD TRACK & FIELD MVP AWARDS

MOST VALUABLE FRESHMAN. MARK HARRIS

Participating in his first year ever of Varsity Track & Field,
Mark Harris helped establish Southfield High a definite threat in the
Sprint Events for seasons to come. Running primarily the 220 Yard Dash
and the Sprint Relays, Mark ran to 6TH overall in the 220 at the SMA
CHAMPIONSHIPS and 2ND at the 9th Grade Oakland County Meet. Mark broke
and re-broke his own Freshman School Record in the 220 on 4 separate
occaisions. He also ran the second leg of our 400 and 800 Meter Relays.
Both relays placed 2ND in the SMA and the 400 Meter relay placed 2ND in
Oakland County. Mark looks forward to both Football and Track in his
Sophomore year. Congradulations Mark Harris: 1980 Most Valuable Freshman.

MOST VALUABLE SOPHOMORE. REGGIE HAYES

Reggie Hayes becomes the first Sophomore ever to receive MVP Honors for the second straight year. Reggie's double threat of throwing and relay running earned him the position of 5TH highest scorer on the team. In the Shot Put, Reggie added nearly 5 feet to his best throw as a Freshman in taking 4 Firsts, 3 Seconds, and ranking 4TH overall in the SMA. Personally motivated for success, he did most of his Shot Put training on his own. Reggie also ran the anchor leg of our 440 Yard Relay team which in dual meet competition scored nearly 80% of the total possible points ranking the event on top for 1980. His relay team THUNDERED to 2ND place in the SMA and 6TH in the REGION. For Reggie, Football is the next challenge. An athlete the coaching staff took pride in all season long, Congradulations Reggie Hayes: 1980 Most Valuable Sophomore.

MOST VALUABLE JUNIOR. FREEMAN DONLOE

Freeman Donloe, in his ROOKIE YEAR of Track & Field stepped off the JV Football practice field onto the track and runways and established himself one of the top Long Jumpers and Sprinters in the County. Freeman began track in February trying most every event and ended up long jumping (discovered by Vincent Bean) and sprint relay running. In the Long Jump Freeman broke the School Junior Record and placed 2ND in the SMA and 5TH in Oakland County. He also shares in the School Record 3 Man Long Jump Relay which was broken twice this season. In the Sprint Relays he ran legs of the 440 and Mile Relays. Both placed 2ND in the SMA with the 440 Relay placing 2ND in the County and is ranked 6TH in the State! Freeman also ran a leg of Southfield's Shuttle Low Hurdle Relay which bagged 4TH Place at both the Lahser and Ambrose Relays. Freeman looks forward now to Football Season and is Southfield's top prospect for the 1981 State Championship Track & Field Meet. Congradulations Freeman Donloe: 1980 Most Valuable Junior.

MOST VALUABLE SENIOR · VINCENT BEAN

In his two seasons of Track at Southfield High, Vincent Bean rewrote the track record books and asserted himself one of the most talented athletes ever at Southfield High. Vincent's Field credentials this year include re-breaking the School Long Jump Record on four occassions. The last time he did it at Hazel Park breaking the School, Stadium, and SMA records; and equalling the State Long Jump Record at 23-11. Vincent repeated as SMA and REGIONAL Champion in the Long Jump and added an Oakland County Championship to his credit. Finishing 3RD in the State earned him the honor of representing the State of Michigan at the Midwest Meet Of Champions where Track & Field All-Stars from Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, and Michigan compete in a Post Season Quadrangular Meet. Vincent's track credentials are as impressive. Anchoring Southfield's 440 Yard Relay team the foursome placed 2ND in the County and was ranked 6TH in the State. Anchoring Southfield's Mile Relay team the foursome placed 2ND in the SMA. Vincent was judged 2ND in the SMA in the 100 Yard Dash and placed 3RD in the REGION. Currently Vincent holds 4 individual records, shares in 5 Relay records, and holds 1 SMA Record. Enrolled at the University of Michigan next fall, he looks forward to College Football with the Wolverines and has not yet ruled out Long Jumping for U of M Track & Field. Congradulations and Best Wishes to 1980 Most Valuable Senior, Vincent Bean.
