Rice rolls in Lahser Relays

The Warriors did it again Saturday.

The Brother Rice track team followed right on the heels of its victory in its own Brother Rice Relays by winning the Bloomfield Hills Lahser Relays on Saturday.

Rice topped the 20-team field with 26 points. Birmingham Seaholm and Farmington tied for second with 20 points.

The Warriors won two relays and finished in the top three in four others. The big men paced Rice. The team of Bob Fallon, Mark Lytle and Jim Browne won the shot put relay (143 feet, 11 inches). And Fred Konkel, Lytle and Browne set a Lahser Relay record in the discus relay, winning with a total of 450-4.

The Rice team of Chris Yaw, Chris Dorcey, Joe Davey and Dim Sullivan was second in the two-mile relay (18:28.4). John Cunningham, Balph Carolin, Mike Greenwell and Ward Bobitz teamed up for second in the mile relay (3:31.2).

Bobitz, Greenwell, Carolin and John MacManus were third in the middle distance relay (5:49.3). And the team of Bob O'Donnell, Greg Kiselis, Carolin and Browne finished third in the shuttle hurdle relay (59.8).

Seaholm won two relays and finished in the top three of two others. The team of Jim Roth, Jim Rosenthal and Mike Morrow won the pole vault rélay (36-0). John Worsley, Andy Fremuth, Mark Redman and Scott Harper won the middle distance relay (5:46.2).

Fremuth, Redman, Worsley and Harper finished second in the distance medley relay (10:45.1). Steve Ross, Steve Rose and Greg Thelike were third in the discus relay (137-2).

Farmington won the long jump relay. The team of Don

Dewar, Craig Kielty and Rick Curtis set a meet record with a total of 63-10.

Second-place Southfield also eclipsed the old record with a total of 62-9%. More importantly, Vincent Bean set a South-field school record with the best individual effort of the meet; a leap of 23 feet, four and one-half inches.

Farmington failed to win another relay, but the Falcons finished in the top three in four other events. The team of Kielty, Dewar, Curtis and Kevin Davis was second in the 880-yard relay (1:33.2). Kielty, Dave Erwin, Dewar and Chris Rennels finished second in the shuttle hurdle relay (59.5).

Erwin, Jeff Beard and Kielty were third in the high jump relay (17-5). Rick Collett, Tom Rogers and Bill Steiner were third in the pole vault relay (22-6).

The Utica Ford team of Mark Almon, Jeff McKellvie and Mark Artish won the high jump relay (17-6).
