His gutty performances in the Spring of 1981 truely earned him the honor of being referred to as "Mr. Sensation".

Darryll dedicated four years of his High School athletic career to Southfield Track & Field, so it seems more than fitting we dedicate this, the 1981 Season Summary Booklet to Senior Co-captain Darryll Miller. We wish him the best of luck in the near future in his Freshman year of studies at Howard University. For Southfield, the 1981 Track Season proved to be one of great improvement and success. Again the Jays demonstrated depth in events and had athletes backing up their Champions. We scored many FIRSTS this season and backed them up with SECONDS and THIRDS. That's the key to success in Track & Field! We narrowly missed netting the SMA Crown, placing 2ND in the League. Led by sprinters and hurdlers, the Blue Jays placed 5TH in the Region and 6TH in the County.

In SMA competition, Berkley lacked the talent to win dual meets, but managed victories over MSAA teams Troy Athens and Lathrup. Berkley boasted Champion Dennis Keane who won both the Mile and Two Mile at the League Meet. Kimball and Andover tied for 6TH place. Kimball had League High Jump Champion Mike Bryson. Andover seems to hold future strength, but their top athletes Mike Carroll, Ken Cutler, and Robin Peterson couldn't bag a FIRST at the League Meet. Hazel Park was paced by Half Mile Champion Don Tuski and Pole Vaulter Harold Thibodeau, but bad luck with injuries to solid athletes cost them a good dual meet record. Ferndale had only 2 losses in the League but placed 4TH in the standings. Disappointing performances at the League Meet cost them an outside shot at 2ND place. Seaholm had 2 Champions: Jim Roth, Pole Vault; and Steve Rose, Shot Put. Strong performances by their distance runners David Bowden and Doug Krause lifted Seaholm past Ferndale to In the dual meet season, Troy got by Southfield in one of 3RD place. the finest dual meets of the season. Going into the League Meet, the Jays were 35 point underdogs but true to 1981 style they refused to fold and led by 1 point going into the last event. The Colts won that event, the Jays placed 4TH and dreams of a Co-Championship evaporated. Southfield was led by Champions Freeman Donloe, 100, 200, Long Jump; a 400 Meter Relay team, and Cornelius Edwards, High Hurdles. Troy had Bradd Morse, Discus Throw; Doug Pfau, 400; Jack Johansson, Low Hurdles; and both an 800 and Mile Relay team.

In 1982, the Jays will have many experienced Track & Field athletes. It is our wish that these athletes have grown mentally, physically, and spiritually this past season. We now look to the future and to what we can do to promote and improve Southfield Track & Field. We must understand what it means to make a commitment to self-improvement and to take pride in honest work.
