

Titans take regional title

Nicole Sylvain won the long jump (16-10½) and the 400 meter dash (59.17) and ran legs on two winning relay teams to pace Pontiac Catholic to a third place finish in girls' Class D track and field regional at Caro High.

Michigan Lutheran Seminary won with 100 points followed by Deckerville with 92 and the Titans with 87.

Lisa Einheuser won the 3200 meter run (12:07) and finished third in the 1600 meter run.

Kecia Green won the 100 meter dash and placed third in the 200 meter dash behind second place finisher Sylvain.

Julie Rouleau, Rhoda Stephens and Yvette Morgan teamed with Sylvain on the 400 meter relay while Sylvain, Green, Rouleau and Stephens ran on the 800 meter relay team.

In the boys' Class C regional at Armada, Damon Jones won the long jump (21-5) and Geoffrey Craig took the 220-yard dash (23.1) as Detroit Country Day finished third with 67 points. Lutheran West won with 94 points and Lake Fenton was second with 87.

Jones, Troy Hudson, Paul Chewins and Charles Adams ran on the winning Yellow Jacket 440 relay (45.8) while Dave Cavotti, Don Cook, Bill Hunter and Craig ran on the winning mile relay (3:34.5).

In the boys' Class C regional at Linden, Holly's 58 points was second to champion Flint Beecher, who scored 160.
