

Lumen Christi Powers Past Cards, 102-29

JACKSON — Four Jackson Lumen Christi thinclads won two events apiece here yesterday as the Titans swept first place in every event except the pole vault, christening their new all-weather facility with a 102-29 victory over Jim Bilsborrow's Coldwater High School track club.

While pole-vaulting veteran Ch. Neutz' 12'6" was the Caru. ls' only winning effort, three other Coldwater performers turned in outstanding "eer best efforts that captured second places.

Mike Stahly heaved the shot 45'7", the third consecutive time he has bettered his previous best effort, and junior Rich Cole added a 43'10 and a half toss that gave Coldwater a two-three finish in the event.

The Cards' had two other outstanding performances. The first came in the mile, where Bret Norton came within two-tenths of a second of shading the Coldwater record with a 4:27.8, but still could manage no better than a third behind the Titans' state

mile champ, John Adams.

The second came from Cardinal workhorse Rick Rurka, who gained a second place in the long jump when he sailed 20'5". Rurka placed in every event he entered, taking seconds in both hurdles races and adding a third in the high jump by clearing 5'8".

"We took five seconds and eight thirds," commented Cardinal mentor Bilsborrow, "but we just couldn't seem to get those first place points to make a contest out of it."

Lumen Christi's big guns were Adams in the mile and two mile, J. Barden, winner of both hurdles races, J. O'Dowd, who took both the high jump and long jump, and Jabe, winner of the shot put and discus. O'Dowd waited until his third jump in the long jump to leap 20'7 and three quarters inches to just clip Rurka's effort, and Barden just nipped the Cardinal co-captain at the tail end of the high hurdles. Adams, only 5'4" but a human enduro, took the two mile with a 9:41.9 clocking.

The loss drops Coldwater's dual meet record to 5-3; with two conference double dual meets coming up next week. Tuesday the Cards will face Sturgis and Jackson Northwest at the Sturgis track, and Thursday will make up a meet with Harper Creek and Marshall at Cardinal Field. Starting times for both meets is 4:30.
