

**Ralph Hill  
Grabs Spot  
In National**

Harding High School graduate Ralph Hill has qualified for the national Junior Olympics meet by placing second in the high hurdles in AAU Junior Olympics action at Evansville, Ind., over the weekend.

Hill, considered one of the state's better hurdlers during his senior year with the Prexies, placed second in a very close and fast-paced 100-meter hurdles race at the Evansville meet.

Tom Wilcher of Detroit streaked to the win in 13.6 seconds, while Hill finished second at 14 flat to qualify for the national meet to be held Aug. 6-9 at Winston-Salem, N.C.

His 14 flat effort was his fastest time ever in the 110-meter event. The Prexy grad has already announced his plans to attend the University of Cincinnati in the fall.

His former coach, Lee Myers, said the Marion Run For Fun Club is currently seeking sponsors to help pay for Hill's trip to Winston-Salem. Those interested should contact the Prexy coach (383-4576).
