Harper Falls To Cardinals

HARPER CREEK — Coach Jim Bilsborrow's Coldwater High School harriers endured one of their most rugged and challenging tests of the season here last night, outlasting host Harper Creek and the demanding Binder Park circuit to take a 23-32 Twin Valley victory.

"This will be the toughest course we'll see all year," said Bilsborrow, "and to do as well as we did here in the heat and on the hills is a real achievement. Harper has traditionally been tough at home because of this course."

The Cards, led by junior Scott Summitt and Scott Gleason, who took second and third, nailed down five of the first seven places enroute to the win.

Summitt's 18:19 and Gleason's 18:21 trailed Harpers' first place finisher, Larry Quick (17:54), and when the Beavers' Clint Crabtree took fourth the score was knotted.

But Cardinals came home in the next three places to clinch the CHS victory. John Puorro led the pack with an 18:38 finish, Scott Licht took sixth in 18:55, and Mike Fadden came home seventh in 19:17. Fadden helped lock up Coldwater's win at the Union City Invitational Saturday with a 17:06 win in the sophomore race.

The Cardinals face Harper again Saturday when the two will meet in the Class B portion of the Vicksburg Invitational.

The Cards are now 5-3 overall and 2-1 in the Twin Valley, and will return to conference action next Wednesday when they host Sturgis and Hastings at Messenger Lake.
