# Runners Take 3rd Cardinal

**VICKSBURG** — Coach Jim Bilsborrow's Coldwater High cross country team survived rain and stiff competition here Saturday to finish third in the Vicksburg Invitational behind the host school and Gull Lake.

Cardinal junior Scott Summitt placed an overall seventh (17:18) to lead the CHS harriers past teams from Delton, Harper Creek, Three Rivers, and Coloma. The CHS harriers narrowly missed nipping Gull Lake for second place as the Blue Devils slipped by 84-86.

Sophomore Mike Fadden earned the team's Hungry Dog award by finishing 16th overall, the second Cardinal to finish. Scott Gleason took 17th, Steve uhl 20th, and John Puorro 26th for the Cardinal runners.

Mariane Exelby ran one of her best races of the season to finish in 21:34 and take 14th place and a medal in the girls' portion of the event.

Tait Norton and Dave Youtsey earned junior varsity awards in their race, and eighth-grader Brian Licht took 21st in the junior high chase.

Coldwater will return to conference competition Wednesday when they host Twin Valley rivals Sturgis and Hastings for a 5 o'clock chase at their Messenger Lake course.
