

Northern girls win Ferris indoor meet

BIG RAPIDS — Flint Northern's girls' track team made it 2-for-2 with a convincing victory Friday in the Ferris State College indoor meet. The three-time defending Class A state champions won the Western Michigan meet last week.

The Vikings' score of 111½ points outclassed the nearest competitor, Grand Rapids Ottawa Hills, by 36½ points.

Northern bagged titles in four individual events and two relays. It added six second places and one third.

Two meet records were set, including the 37 feet 10 inches effort by Viking shot putter Felicia Cooper.
