Dear Coach:

Would you like your trackmen to run for the High School Mile Relay Championship on the board track at the Pontiac Silverdome?

This event is being conducted in connection with the NCAA Indoor Track Championsips March 12 and 13.

The races have been sanctioned by the Michigan High School Athletic Association and are subject to its eligibility rules. Jack Cotton, Athletic Director for the Farmington Schools, is director of the competition. All senior high schools in Wayne, Oakland, Macomb and Washtenaw counties are eligible.

The University of Michigan will conduct qualifying races for the High School Mile Relay at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, March 3 at the U. of M. Track and Tennis Building in Ann Arbor. The building is located at Ferry Field.

Unlike previous years the top 3 qualifiers from the City section and top 3 from the suburban section will vie for the title in a one race championship on Saturday, March 13 in the Silverdome. The winning team will receive a trophy and all 6 teams will receive individual medals.

You may register for the Ann Arbor qualifying races when you arrive on March 3rd.

Eligibility forms for athletes competing in the Silverdome championships on March 13 must be submitted by Tuesday, March 9 to Jack Cotton.

NOTICE: If your team qualifies for and competes in the Silverdome championships, it will count as ONE DAY of competition under the MHSSA Sports Limitation Rule.
