

# Northern wins two events, ends third in Huron Relays

Northern High's third-place in the Huron Relays included two first places: Maurice Chestnut with a 13-foot 8-inch effort in the pole vault and the two-mile relay (Joe Sparrow, Robert Lemuel, Nigel Barister, Joe Caldwell) in 8:09.3 minutes.

Other Vikings contributing to a 35-point total behind winner Taylor Center and runner-up Detroit Central were Kerry Ware, seventh, 60-yard dash, sprint medley relay (Sparrow, Quinton Estes, Mel Brannon, Caldwell), third, 3:40.7, and mile relay (Sparrow, Ware, Brannon, Caldwell) sixth, 3:35.8.

Northwestern earned points with Clayton Alexander's fourth in the long jump (21-3), Darryl Lawson's third in the high hurdles (7-8), fifth in the shuttle hurdle relay (3:09) and fifth in the 880 relay (1:36.6).

Ron Hill of Grand Blanc was third in the two-mile (9:29.7) and seventh in the mile (4:33.7).

For Central, Darryl Terry had a fifth-place long jump (20-10½), a fifth in the sprint medley relay (Archie Smyers, Terry, Derrick Leonard, Bubba Sanders) in 3:44.4 and fourth in the mile relay (3:34.7). Southwestern's Phil Mitchell ran third in the 60 with 6.6 to go with a fifth-place mile relay in 3:35.2.

Kearsley's Tony Todd, Tim Marsh, Craig Adas and Tim Helms placed first in the distance medley relay in 10:43.7 and third in the two-mile in 8:12.6. The Hornets also had a 12-foot-8 pole vault for fourth and a 10:02.7 two-mile by Mike Wiltze.
