

# Relays titles in C, D won by Detroit teams

sive in the shuttle hurdle relay. The team of Ann Vereen, Kristi Jackson, Sue Crawford and Kandis Davis skimmed the hurdles in 32.07, destroying the old meet record by 3.99 seconds.

"We work on (the hurdles) hard every day," said Prosperi. "We have half a dozen girls who could have competed today — two of them are on vacation. We try to stress everything. As Mr. (Bruce) Waha says, 'If you ignore kids in the hurdles, you're not going to do anything.' And we start them very young."

Jackson's victory in the high jump Friday. "We went to a clinic here (in January) and he offered a lot of hints on the high jump. He allowed our girl to go from 4-8 to 5-2."

In the meet's Class D portion, Detroit St. Andrew scored 53 points to crisply win the team championship. St. Andrew swept to victories in every relay; the shuttle hurdle, the sprint medley, the 880 and mile.

Dansville, the only Lansing-area team in Class D, finished 11th with 11 points.

There were no area winners in either class. Highest finisher was Perry's Tracy Pearce, who nipped Williamston's Kari Roosa for second place in the Class C 60-yard dash. Country Day's Vereen was far

ahead of the local girls, clocking 7.4 to Pearce's 7.7 and Roosa's 7.8.

The Class A and B girls take the track today, with action starting at 10 a.m. on the 220-yard Jenison oval.

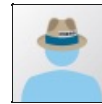
