

Detroit Central off to fast start in Dayton relays

DAYTON, Ohio — Central High of Detroit, the Michigan Class A track and field champion, scored well here Saturday night in the early events of the Dayton Roosevelt Relays.

Central's Tom Wilcher set a record of 13.6 seconds in winning the 110-meter high hurdles. Central's 800-meter relay team of David Beasley, Vince Hall, Mark Jett and William White won the event in 1:27.1.

Central and Columbus (Ohio) Wehrle tied in the 400-meter relay, as both were clocked in 42.1 seconds. Beasley was second in the 400-meter open event while William Hill of Detroit Cody won the 1,600-meter open event in 3:22.1.
