

Olivet, Fowler tops in CMAC title meet

BELLEVUE — Olivet High rode the efforts of five individuals to take the boys' Central Michigan Athletic Conference track title here Wednesday night. Fowler's girls put together their second straight CMAC title, winning eight of 15 events.

Olivet amassed 101 points to walk away with its title, easily outdistancing (in order) Laingsburg, Fowler, Pottersville, Bellevue, Fulton and Portland St. Patrick. The Fowler girls had it nearly as easy, totaling 138 points, 58 better than second-place Olivet. Fulton accumulated 75 points, to hold off late-charging Laingsburg, which totaled 70, for third place. Pottersville finished fifth, Bellevue was sixth, and Portland St. Patrick did not score.

ROB BRAMER earned top honors in the 100-, 200-, and 400-meter dashes to pace the Olivet boys. Teammate **Ernie Winchell** won both hurdle events, running the 110-meter highs in 15.4, and the 300-meter lows in 40.9. Other Olivet winners included David Judd, Tim Schriener and Rich Pewe, who won the pole vault, 1,600-meter run, and 3,200-meter run, respectively.

A majority of the winning Fowler points came from two victorious relay teams, and three dual winners in Becky Klein, Lana Halner, and Emily Feldpausch. Both Feldpausch and Halner set school records while winning the 1,600-meter run and high jump, respectively. Feldpausch's other title came in the 3,200-meter run. Halner's in the 800-meter run. Klein took top laurels in the 200- and 400-meter dashes.

Pottersville's **Todd Saylor** and Fowler's **Dave Koenigsnecht** each won two events. Saylor took both weight titles, heaving the discus 135 feet, 1 inch, and putting the shot 43-1 1/4. Koenigsnecht high jumped 6-3, and long jumped 21-5/4 for first-place medals.

TERRI MURPHY won three events for the Olivet girls — the discus, shot put, and long jump. Murphy won the discus with a throw 107-8, the shot put with a 37-10 toss, and the long jump with a 15-8 3/4 leap. Laingsburg's **Jodi Palmer** earned firsts in the 100-meter dash and the 200-meter low hurdles with times of 13.2 and 30.5, respectively.

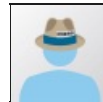
