GENERAL INFORMATION

1. OFFICIALS - The Officials' Tent will be located near the south end of the football field.
2. REGISTRATION - Coaches should pick up their packet near the Concession Stand. Contestants' numbers, pins, programs and heat and lane assignments will be issued. Coaches must make sure their contestants wear assigned numbers.
- *3. TEAMS WITH RELAYS - Relay cards are enclosed in the coaches packet. It is the coaches responsibility to record name, number, and school on the relay cards to be presented to the Clerk of Course.
4. DRESSING ROOM - Two dressing rooms will be available for contestants. The girls will use #1 and the boys will use #2 locker rooms which are located under the stadium. Schools should use their own towels. Valuables should be checked with your coach or some other reliable person.
5. MEALS - Schools are responsible for their own meals. Meal tickets may be purchased for \$2.00 per person at the Concession Stand. Meals will be served in the cafeteria of Northwestern Community High School starting at 11:00 a.m.
6. CONTESTANT SEATING AREA - All contestants must sit in the designated area as shown on enclosed map. This area will be in the N.W. section of the stands.
7. BULL PEN - The bull pen will be located at the northwest end of the Stadium. All contestants should report to the Clerk of Course in this area.
8. TRAINING - A trainer will be available in the bull pen area.
9. WARM UP - The warm up area will be on the west side of the Stadium in the Driver Training Area. Contestants should be warmed up and ready to compete at the scheduled time.
10. TIME SCHEDULE - A time schedule has been included for your convenience.
11. TRACK EVENTS - All track events of 400 meters or more will be run in front of the stands. The 100 meter dash, 100 meter low hurdles and 110 meter high hurdles will be run in front of the stands. The 200 meter dash and hurdles will start on the opposite side of the track with staggered starts and finish in front of the stands. The 300 meter low hurdles will start on the opposite side of the track and finish in front of the stands.
12. FIELD EVENTS - All Field Events will be held in the areas indicated on your enclosed map.
3. HEAT QUALIFIERS - The selection of qualifiers to the Semis and Finals of the Dashes and Hurdles will be by place finishes in preliminary heats.
1. SCRATCHES - Final scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie by 9:00 a.m. at the concession stand. All contestants entered in an event must compete in that event, or the contestant will be disqualified for the remainder of the meet.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

NOTE: All finals will be run in order and as fast as possible. There will be no delays for runners in the finals.

All contestants will remain in the stands until 1st call is made whereby they will be allowed to enter the bull pen.

All final scratches must be made to Mary LaVoie at the concession stand by 9:00 a.m.

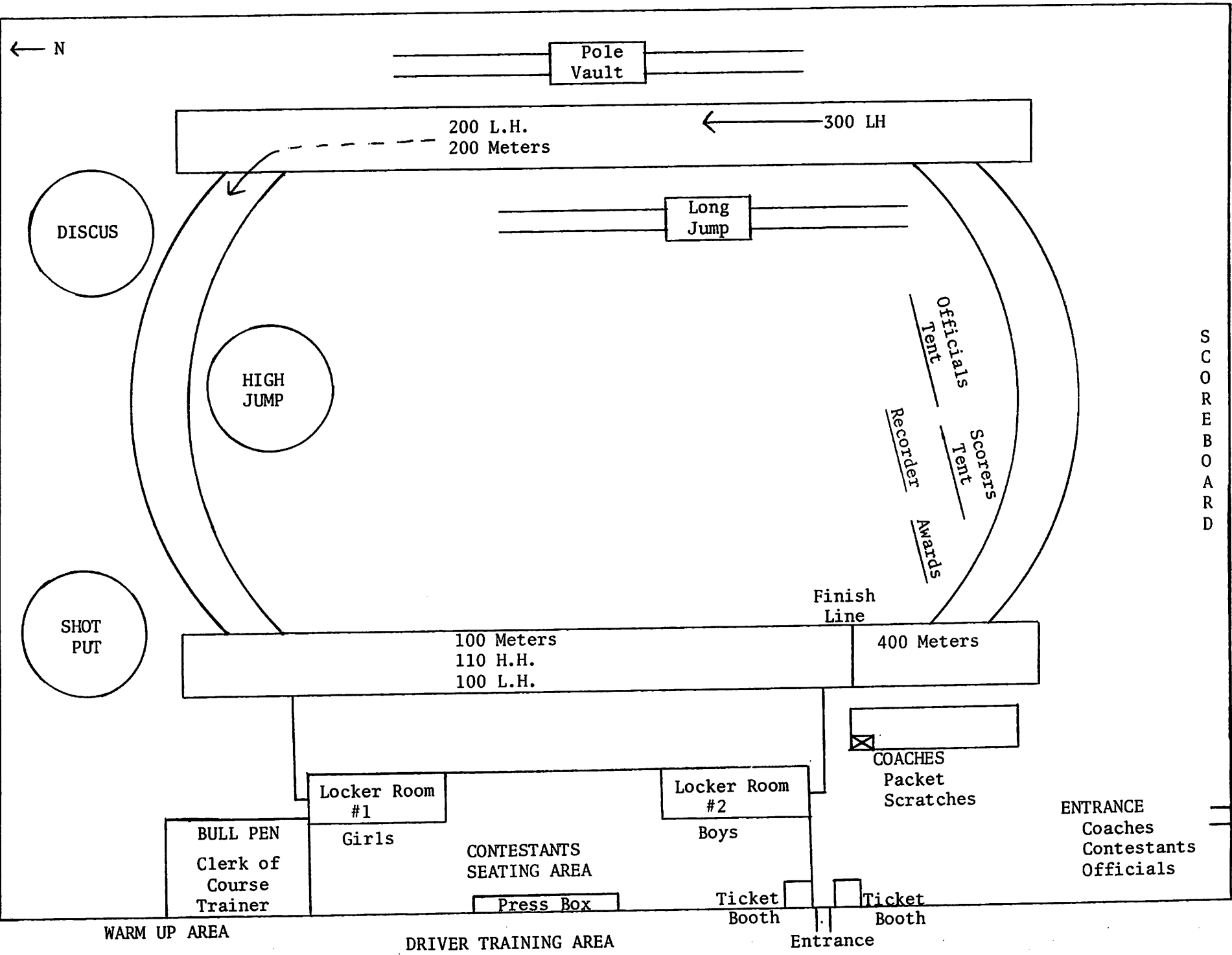
Your cooperation is requested to keep contestants and spectators in their proper places as outlined below. Please discuss these items with your team:

1. All track shoes MUST HAVE $\frac{1}{4}$ " SPIKES OR LESS in order to run on the all-weather track. Trackmen who do not follow this rule WILL NOT be allowed to participate in the track meet.
2. Gill starting blocks will be available for use. No individual school starting blocks will be permitted on the track.
3. Contestants and coaches should stay in the northwest section of the stands as designated.
4. Please ask your athletes to stay away from officials at the finish line.
5. Each team is expected to furnish its own equipment in all field events.
6. Rules governing the State Meet are set forth in the 1982 Track and Field Rule Book and the Michigan State Athletic Department Bulletin of March, 1982.
7. Please warm up 15 minutes prior to the time indicated in the track and field events.
8. NO EVENT will be held up for contestants not at the starting post.
9. We would appreciate all coaches staying with their team and keeping them in the designated seat area.
10. There will be no SUBSTITUTIONS for athletes qualifying from the Regional Entry Form except as allowed in the relay events.

Registration:

Coaches are to obtain information kits containing numbers, heat sheets, time schedule, pins, etc., on arrival in the stadium at the concession stand.

NOTE - COACHES - make sure contestants wear assigned numbers and that the numbers are fastened top and bottom so flapping will not occur.

Scratches

Scratches may be called in by the head coaches, to Dick Leach 313-762-1030, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. starting Monday, May 24 to Wednesday, May 26. Please call in as soon as possible on your scratches.

Drawing of heats and lanes will take place at Dick Leach's house at 4033 W. Court St., Flint, Mich. on Thursday, May 27, 1982 at 7:00 p.m. All final scratches should be made at the concession stand to Mary LaVoie prior to 9:00 a.m.

Dressing Accommodations:

Dressing rooms will be available for contestants. The lockerrooms are located under the stadium. Schools should furnish their own towels. Valuables should be checked with your coach or some other reliable person.

Discus & Shot Puts

All shot puts and discus must be weighed in by the management. Please check the weight of your shot and discus before arriving to avoid disqualifying at weigh-in. The head field judge will make an announcement as to exact time and place of weigh-in.

Track Events

All track events of 400 Meters or more will be run from the center of the straightaway in front of the stands. The 100 Meter Dash, 100 Meter Low Hurdles, and the 110 Meter High Hurdles will be run in front of the stands. The 200 Meter Dash will start on the opposite side of the track with staggered starts and finish in front of the stands. The 300 Meter Low Hurdles will start on the opposite side of the track and finish in front of the stands.

Running Instructions:

1. Coaches are to check rules regarding limitations for contestants. Rules governing the State Meet are set forth in the 1982 Track and Field Rules Book and the Michigan State Athletic Department Bulletin of March, 1982.
2. No event will be held up for contestants not at the starting post!
3. There will be NO SUBSTITUTIONS FOR ATHLETES qualifying from the Regional Entry Form except as allowed in the relay events.
4. Instruct runners to stay in lanes on completion of races, run in lanes, and turn back to the judges (walk backward toward finish line) so that the number may be seen by timers and judges.
5. Please ask your athletes to stay away from officials at the finish line.
6. AWARDS: Medals will be presented at the awards stand following the event.

Houston Stadium has a new Reslite all-weather surface. All marking materials for field and running events on the track must be athletic tape ONLY or some other substance off the track.

Directions:

The State A Finals will again be held at Guy V. Houston Stadium which is located adjacent to Flint Northwestern High School. The address is G-2138 W. Carpenter Rd. Perhaps the easiest way to Houston Stadium is to drive I-75 Expressway and turn off at the Pierson Road exit towards Flint (east). Drive approximately one (1) mile east and turn left (north) at second light, Clio Road. Go approximately one (1) mile and turn (east) on to Carpenter Road. Continue approximately 3/4 of a mile and Houston Stadium is located on the left hand side (north) of Carpenter Road.
