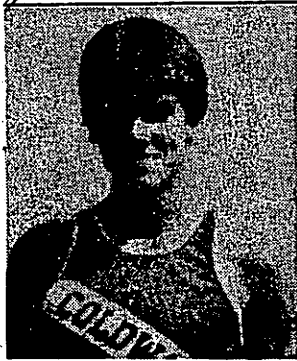

Summitt, Exelby Grab Records

Scott Summitt and Marianne Exelby both set school records Wednesday as Coldwater High's cross country team ran by

Summitt ran the course in 16:10.5, good enough for both a school and a course record.

Bret Norton held the previous Cardinal record of 16:28.3, set in 1981. The course record was set by Keith Keyser of Sturgis in 1980 when he ran a 16:11.2.

Exelby held the record before Wednesday's run at 20:56, but she ran the three-mile course almost one minute faster, coming in at 19:57.6. Exelby's nearest competitor was Char Gibbs of Hastings, who had beaten Exelby at the Sturgis Invitational by four seconds. Gibbs was clocked at 20:27 Wednesday.

Scott Licht was second for the Cardinal boys, running a 16:53. Mike Shaw topped Hastings with a third place

finish of 17:14. The Saxons took fourth and fifth, but Kevin Sussex, Brian Licht and Mike Fadden followed to clinch the win for Coldwater.

The Cardinals are now 9-2 and in second place in the Twin Valley behind Hillsdale.

Coldwater will host the Branch County Championship on Friday, which is sponsored by the Coldwater Optimist Club. Teams from Bronson and Union City will be competing for team and individual honors. The boy's varsity will get the race underway at 4:30 p.m. and the girls and reserves will run at 5 p.m. The race will be held at Messenger Lake Park.
