I don't know how many coaches caught it, but one of the top runners in one of the individual races DID NOT RUN IN THE REGIONAL.

This was caught by a coach that gave me a call after the state meet. At first I thought that there was a wrong name in the results from that regional and the individual that ran in the state meet was the correct runner. That turned out to be false. The regional in question had 11 runners entered in the individual race, rather than the maximum number of 10. How did that happen----- it's a long story.... And as I understand it was okayed by the MHSAA..... I have not had time to verify everything other than the runner in question did not run in his regional race.....

It seems that the regional in question sent out an incorrect time schedule six weeks in advance. The athlete in question's race was scheduled for 1:30 instead of the correct time of 12:30. Three weeks before the meet a corrected time schedule was sent out. The race was started at the correct time without the involved runner. The coach raised a protest. The meet management allowed the athlete to run in the other boy's race that was run at 1:30. He was hand timed and his time was compared with his actual race. His time was good enough to place high enough in that race so he was told they would check with the state office to see if he could go. As I understand the state office then gave permission for that regional to send 11 individuals to the State Championship.....

Some interesting questions are raised by this action. 1) five of the athletes team members were on the starting line and ran in the correct race. How come they could make it, but he couldn't. 2) teams are supposed to be called to the starting line and given instructions 10 minutes before the race started. Wouldn't a missing runner or team show up at that time... 3) with the official meet entry from the MHSAA are complete instructions and a schedule of times for all regionals. In Sec 11 a) At all Regional and Final Runs, the first run will start at 12:30 pm. Where there are two classes, the smallest class will compete first. Isn't it the responsibility of the coach to know the rules and procedures of his sport?

At the same time in another regional there was a team that finished third in the regional- qualifies for state NCHS. The same team qualified four individuals for the state individual race- qualified for state team race NCHS. It seems that there were only 7 complete teams. You must have a complete(?) regional for a third team to qualify- a complete regional for individuals to qualify as a team. There were 9-11 schools that actually competed in that regional. What about those kids-- are we being fair- giving them a second chance to qualify. This is not the first time that this has happened to a team.....

There was the possibility of a lawsuit for the football playoffs. It seems that a potential team for the playoffs had a game cancelled because of a teacher strike. The got 4 pts for a win, but the state would not give the points that can be earned as bonus points by teams you beat winning. With them they would have to "on their line" Well they lost the final game so that settled the questions. Why not allow another qualifier ? ? ? ? ? E BACK PAGE.....
