Perfect conditions bring out best in 54th city track meet

Imagine what might happen to the record book if good weather could be guaranteed for all city high school track meets.

The 54th annual meet Wednesday night at Houston Stadium was a perfect example.

Seven of 30 possible records were broken and two others were tied as Northern swept both championships by expected lopsided margins.

Five records fell in the girls' meet which is only 10 years old but two records and two ties in the boys' meet emphasized what could happen with good weather.

Some of the best boys in Flint's history never got solid chances for records because of poor conditions.

For the first time, all four schools ranked the same in both meets.

NORTHERN'S GIRLS won every running event for the third straight year and totaled 139 points against Central's 44½, Northwestern's 28½ and Southwestern's 16. The Vikings outscored the combined total of three rivals for the fifth straight year.

Northern's boys duplicated their record 1982 total of 101 points, winning eight of 16 events and coming within a point of matching last year's victory margin. Central scored 54, Northwestern 49 and Southwestern

Terri Barber and Carlene Isabelle led Northern's sixth straight title and seventh overall.

Robert Lemuel and Anthony Bowie sparked Northern's 24th championship.

BARBER WON both hurdles and anchored winning 400-meter and record-breaking 800-meter relay teams. Her 47.5 seconds time for the 300 hurdles claimed an automatic record for a new distance and she won the 100 hurdles in 14.8.

Alicia Johnson and Monica Taylor were on both relays while Marlene Isabelle helped a record of 1:41.8 in the 800 relay and Shonda Johnson on the 400 which

Carlene Isabelle lowered her 800 meters record to 2:21.3 and broke the one-year-old 1,600-meters record with a clocking of 5:18.1.

The Vikings finished off the meet with a record of 3.59.8 in the 1,600 relay with both Isabelles, Shonda

Colleen Cady swept to a record of 12:08.0 in the 3,200 meters, lapping all except two runners.

"SHE REALLY went after the record," said Northern Coach George Dedrick. "It was a good record, especially after also finishing second in the 1,600."

Dedrick was pleased by the contributions of Darwella Sudbury, Mary Gerdes and Lena Fox, the first

ninth-graders to score for Northern in the city meet. He said, "This is a difficult meet to prepare for but (Assistant Coach) Don Durrett did a great job firing them up.

Also winning for Northern were Taylor in the long jump at 17-4, Tonya James in the discus at 109-2, Marlene Isabelle in the 400 at 57.5, Pam Brown in the 100 at 12.3 and the 200 at 25.6.

Northwestern's Felicia Smith won the high jump at 5-4 and Central's Lenore Richardson's 38-5 won the shot put, making them the first non-Northern champions since 1980.

LEMUEL WON the difficult distance double, taking the 1,600 meters in 4:24.6 and 3,200 meters in 9:40.2, both with comfortable margins.

Bowie won the 300 hurdles in 38.0 and anchored winning 800-meter and 1,600-meter relays. Chris Williams, Kenford Wilson and Stan Ruth were his teammates on a record-setting 3.18.3 time in the longer event with only a four-tenths margin over runner-up Southwestern.

Williams, Quinton Estes and Will Palmer helped on the 800 team.

Frank Robinson won the discus at 132-9, Michael Lacy the pole vault at 13-0 and Williams the long jump at 22-111/2 to help fatten a 38-point total in the field events.

Mark Ingram of Northwestern tied the meet record of 14.4 in the 110 hurdles and helped Andre Rison, Gord Mitchner and Mel Houston lower the 400-meter relay record fo 42.1.

Derrick Leonard of Central equaled the meet record of 10.5 for 100 meters and pushed Rison, a sophomore, to an outstanding time of 21 7 in the 200.

Jeff Grayer of NW took the high jump at 6-5, Tony Cole of SW the shot put at 51-2, Archie Smyers of Central the 400 at 49.2 and Southwestern's Don Younger the 800 in 1:57.8
