

# Boys meet

Grosse Pointe North was the power in the Bi-County dual meet campaign but for awhile Thursday that dominance trembled on a shaky foundation.

The Norsemen flopped in a couple of a field events. And Lakeview came on strong in the races to stay with GP North in the recent standings most of the meet. But the Norsemen had a reservoir of strength to tap in the distance events and hurdles that staked them to a 176-143 margin over Lakeview in the championship duel.

GP North's superiority in the mile and two mile was no surprise to any league observer. The school always has been strong in those events. It was like that when Tom Gauerke was head coach and it's still that way under Bill Korolvech, Gauerke's successor.

"The leadership changes but the tradition stays the same, same," Kuroolvech commented. "Once you start a winning tradition it goes on. Freshmen go out for the cross country team and it leads them into track."

That feeder program produced the distance men who clinched the meet for GP North after a major disappointment in part of the field events.

"We only got three points total in the pole vault and high jump," noted Kuroolvech. "I had figured on at least 28 points. I could see we were going to need some fairly strong performances: we knew Lakeview had good strength for the races."

GP North cleaned up in both hurdles races and dominated two of the distance events as well. Mark Denis and Scott Cooper ran one-two in the mile with Jeff Joseph bringing in a fifth. In the two mile it was Joe Schmidt and Brian Boutell finishing one-two with Joe Carroll taking a fourth,

"Mark Denis is one of the top milers in the state and Joe Schmidt is the top two-miler in the state," the coach related. Both are seniors and All-State runners on the GPN cross country team that won the state meet last fall. Cooper also is an All-State harrier.

Darryl Launis won the 120 yard lows and Will Secor took the highs for GPN in the hurdles. GPN also took the discus (Dave Bergeron) and all the relays plus the 440 (Randy Boone).

Lakeview piled up a heap of points in the field events, winning two (Al Campbell in the shot put, Kevin Raes in the high jump). A.J. Watson and Ray Kauffmann ran one-two in the 100 for a Lakeview double and Kauffman prevailed in the 220. The Huskies also got winning points in the half mile from Brian Krus.

Other winners were Dan Inman, L'Anse Creuse, in the pole vault and Brablec's John Pellerito in the long jump.
