

## Clawson tops girls field

# Fitz rolls to MOAC track title

WARREN — Fitzgerald added another track trophy to its showcase Wednesday as it easily won the Macomb-Oakland Athletic Conference meet with a record 201 points.

Clawson, which got off to a fast start when it picked up 52 points in the field events, took the girls title with 103 points.

"We were undefeated (8-0) in dual meets, won the Sterling Heights and Troy Athens relays and a regional championship, so winning today was no surprise," said Coach Das Campbell.

"What was surprising was that we scored all those points," he continued. "It was a little more than we thought we would get and, really, it's not easy to score 200 points in a league meet."

"But we have had a lot of depth all year, so there was no reason to change anything today," Campbell said.

"I think the other teams cut into each other's totals a bit more than we figured and we got some points from fifth and sixth-place finishers that we had not counted on," he concluded.

The Spartans, scoring in every event, were led by double winners Jim Tanzy and Don Durant.

Tanzy won the shot put at 47-foot-11½ and the discus at 135-11, while Durant skimmed the high hurdles in 15.0 after a winning 6-5 effort in the high jump.

The only other double winners were Tower's Joe Michalic, who led the way in the mile and 880 with times of 4:22.6 and 2:01.8, and Kevin Jarema of Warren Woods who captured the low hurdles and 220 with clockings of 39.9 and 23.3.

Tower took second in the meet with 69 points, five more than Clawson.

"We are really looking forward to the county meet Friday because we think it will be a tough test and get us ready for next week's state meet," Campbell offered.
