# McGuire, Exelby Win County Harrier Titles

Bronson High's Jesse McGuire and Coldwater's Marianne Exelby were the individual winners and Coldwater came away with both team trophy's Friday in the annual Branch County Cross Country Meet at Messenger Lake Park.

The fifth annual run, sponsored by the Optimist Club, saw McGuire capture his second straight county title with a time of 16 minutes, 23.4 seconds while Exelby won the first girl's crown with a time of 20:10.5. The Cardinal boy's won their fifth straight county title while the girl's championship was the first ever.

Coldwater's Scott Gleason placed second to McGuire at 16:34, with teammate Nick Loomis third at 17:35. The Vikings' Brian Coats was fourth at 17:42 and the Cardinals' Brian Licht was right behind at 17:43. Bronson's Dewayne Smith and Greg Anderson captured the two remaining spots on the all-county team.

Coldwater's Paul Fox finished eighth to tie the score between Bronson and the Cards. David Larimer and Jeff Licht came in ninth and 10th, respectively, to lead Coldwater to a 27-29 win. Union City, running without its top two runners, came in a distant

third with 84 points.

The Chargers made their presence known in the girl's race, taking two of the top four places. Defending county champion Terri Forrest grabbed second with a time of 20:23.7, just ahead of Coldwater's Dawn Valle (20:24).

Union City's Bobbi Silva was fourth and Bronson's Jean Miller, Shantel Houck and Beth Barrows claimed the next three places to round out the all-county team.

The Cards' Michelle Laughry (8th), Shelly Thompson (9th) and Shelly Angle (11th) helped Coldwater take home the team trophy with 32 points.

The boy's jayvee race ended in a 28-28 tie between Coldwater and Bronson, with the Vikings breaking the tie and getting the win on the basis of their sixth man's finish. Coldwater's Jason Grupp won the race with a time of 19:02.3.

All three schools will compete in respective league meets Tuesday. Coldwater will go to Sturgis for the Twin Valley meet, Union City will host the Big Eight meet and Bronson will head to Bellevue where the Vikings will be favored to win the Southern Michigan Athletic Association meet.
