Card Harriers Outrun By Hornets, 'Skins

It was "a meet we've been waiting for a long time," according to Coldwater High cross country coach Jim Bilsborrow, but it turned out to be one he'd just as soon forget.

The Cardinals hosted Twin Valley foes Hillsdale and Marshall Wednesday, and they lost to the Hornets 26-30 and Redskin 23-32. The Coldwater girls fared no better, falling to Hillsdale 22-33 and Marshall 23-35.

Scott Gleason of Coldwater did provide some consolation, outrunning Hillsdale's Joe Parzych, last spring's T-V two-mile champ, for first place. Gleason covered the course in 16 minutes, 19.8 seconds, the sixth-fastest time ever run on the course in the past 10 years.

Gleason took the lead at the 1½ mile mark when Parzych missed a flag. When Parzych got back on course, Gleason was long gone. The Hornet

finished in 16:35.

Hillsdale's Mark Osbourne was next at 16:47, then a quartet of Marshall runners, led by Scott Simmons' fourth place time of 17:11, came across. Coldwater's Mike Fadden and Nick Loomis were eighth and ninth and Brian Licht was 13th. Matt Morgan, running his best race of the year, placed 16th.

Hillsdale's veteran girl's team dominated the race, led by Cathy Acus who was first at 19:35. The Hornets followed with fourth, sixth, seventh and eighth place finishes. Marshall's Diane Weaver was second with a time of 19:54.

Dawn Valle paced Coldwater by running third at 20:25. Marianne Exelby placed fifth at 20:41.

Both Cardinal teams will run Saturday at the Charger Invitational at Union City.
