

Tiger Girls Off To Fast Start

GRAND RAPIDS — Benton Harbor's girls track team got off to a fast start here Saturday, winning their third consecutive Pat Patterson Indoor Relays title at East Kentwood High School.

Coach Eddie Watson's Tigers took five firsts while piling up 53 points to outdistance runnerup East Kentwood, which finished with 46.

Taking firsts for the Tigers in the 19-team field were Angelique Bell in the shot put (38-8), Carolyn Ferguson in the high jump (5-2) and three relay units.

Winning Tiger relay teams were the four-lap unit of Carolyn Ferguson, Karla Bell, Shauna Burton and Linda McMillion in 1:28.3; the sprint medley team of Burton, Nona Dean, Cheryl Williams and McMillion in a fieldhouse record time of 2:21.99; and

the mile relay unit of Ferguson, Burton, Lolita Cotton and McMillion in 4:23.16.

Taking second for the Tiger girls was the hurdle relay unit of Iris White, Paris Crafton, Cheryl White and Ferguson, while Michelle Rimpson was third in the 60-yard dash in 7.62 seconds.

On the boys' side of the ledger, Benton Harbor's Curtis McManus won the 60-yard dash in 6.38 seconds.
