Central shatters Viking track run

Derrick Leonard had an additional reason to celebrate after winning his third straight 100-meter sprint championship Wednesday in the city high school track meet at Houston Stadium.

Unlike his previous victories, this time Leonard could rejoice in being part of the winning team.

The Central speedster won two sprints and was also a member of a triumphant relay quartet as the Indians ended Northern's two-year reign as champion.

Paced by Leonard, the Indians scored in 16 of 17 events to tally 92½ points for their first boys' title since 1981 and their 21st in the 55-year history of the meet.

Southwestern also outscored Northern, 61-54½, leaving the Vikings in third place, their lowest since a similar finish in 1972, the first of five years when Powers Catholic participated to make it a five-team meet. Northwestern scored 26 points to end fourth for the first time since 1981.

While the Northern boys were

yielding their crown, the Northern girls were extending their domination. The Lady Vikings prevailed for the seventh straight year and surpassed 100 points for the sixth successive time.

Northern's girls won 11 events to total 120 points while Central was second with 65. Northwestern was third with 29 and Southwestern fourth for the seventh consecutive year with 10 points.

"We ran well for the terrible weather," said Central boys' Coach Mike Vance, noting how the wind and cold temperatures hampered everyone's performances.

There were no records set but Leonard was closer than anyone to getting into the books. Leonard was timed in 10.6 seconds for the 100, one-tenth off the meet record he matched in 1983.

Leonard also won the 200 and anchored the Vikings' 400 relay team. Daryl'Gilliam was also part of three victories for Central, winning the shot put and running on the 800 and 400 relays. Reggie Gallaspy and Daryl Greer also ran in

both the 800 and 400 relays.

David Burks, the other member of the 800 relay, also won the 300 hurdles. The Indians won 8 events including Stacy Johnson in the high jump and Andy Parker in the 110 hurdles. The Indians placed 1-2-3 in the 110 hurdles and 1-3 in the 300 hurdles.

Southwestern, led by Calvert Gordon, moved ahead of Northern by winning five events to the Vikings' three.

Gordon captured both the 1,600 and 3,200 runs and anchored the Colts' 3,200-relay winner. Butch Wynn led a 1-2 Colt finish in the discus and Lonnie Poole, also a member of the 3,200 relay, won the 800.

Michael Lacy repeated as pole vault champion for Northern while Paul LeSears won the 400 and helped on the Vikings' winning 1,600 relay.

Andre Rison accounted for Northwestern's lone triumph in the long jump and finished second to Leonard in both sprints.

Yvonne Thompson was the most successful performer of the day, winning three individual events to lead the Lady Vikings. Thompson won both hurdles plus

the high jump.

Teammate Shonda Johnson had a hand in three victories, the 400 and two relays and Polly Johnson won the long jump and was a member of one winning relay

Northern's Coleen Cady repeated as the 3,200 winner and Debra Jinnah captured the 800 for
