Cardinal harriers cop Optimist Meet titles

Jesse McGuire and Jill Strawser were the individual champions, but Coldwater High was the overall winner last Friday in the sixth annual Branch County Optimist Club Cross Country Meet.

The Cardinals easily won the boys' meet for the sixth straight year with 21 points. Bronson placed second with 34 and Union City was a distant third with 85 points. The Lady Cards also prevailed in girl's action, as their 22 points bettered runner-up Bronson's 42. Union City was third with 62 points.

Bronson's McGuire won his third straight county race and set the Memorial Park course record in the process. The senior covered the three-mile layout in 15 minutes, 53.4 seconds for the fastest time ever recorded in the course's 11-year history.

Chasing McGuire across the finish line for the second straight year was Coldwater's Scott Gleason, who was clocked in 16:12, less than two seconds off the old course record.

With the Cards' Brian Licht taking third (17:09), Shane Finney fourth (17:22) and Tad Thayer (17:47) nos-

ing out Bronson's Brian Coats (17:48) for fifth, Coldwater was able to post its victory.

McGuire, Gleason, Licht, Finney, Thayer, Coats and Coldwater's Gary Pierce, the seventh place finisher, all were awarded medals by the Optimist Club for making the All-County team. The Optimist Club has sponsored the meet since its inception in 1980.

It was also a record-breaking day for Strawser, as she set the Coldwater record by winning the girls' race in 19:51.8. Marianne Exelby held the previous record of 19:57.6 set in 1983.

Strawser was the first of four Lady Cards to make the All-County team. Runner-up was teammate Dawn Valle at 20:23, while the Redbirds' Joan Monroe placed fourth (20:56) and Michelle Laughry sixth (21:44).

Bronson's Jean Miller edged Monroe for third place at 20:51 and the Vikings' Shantel Houck was fifth at 21:01. Rounding out the All-County team was Terri Forrest of Union City (21:57).

All three schools will compete in their respective league meets on Tuesday and regionals on Saturday.
